APPLICATION GUIDELINES

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PURPOSE: This scholarship, endowed by generous Truett alumni, is intended to help defray the cost of seminary education for current outstanding students at George W. Truett Theological Seminary.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EVALUATION CRITERIA: Applicants must be a current Truett Seminary student seeking a MDiv or MACM degree and should have completed at least 42 hours of coursework required for their degree by the end of the current semester, be currently enrolled at Truett, and have plans to register for the subsequent fall semester. Applicants must also be deemed to have exemplified four achievements/qualities: having maintained a strong academic standing at the seminary, having made a significant contribution to the Truett community by involvement and service on campus, significant ministry involvement in a local church, and having demonstrated a strong potential to represent the seminary well in the future.

PROCESS: Each applicant must submit a complete application form to the Alumni Association Committee comprised of the Alumni Association president and the Truett Alumni Faculty and Staff. Applications should be submitted either by mail to the Assistant Dean of External Affairs, George W. Truett Theological Seminary, One Bear Place #97126, Waco, Texas 76798-7126, or in person to the Assistant Dean of External Affairs Office, Suite 311, Truett Seminary building. Scholarships shall be awarded on an annual basis based on available funding. Applications will be made available during the Spring semester and must be submitted by the published date each year.

PRESENTATION: The annual recipient shall be notified upon the committee's final determination and shall be formally awarded the scholarship at the Fall Convocation following the spring submission.

Scholarship Application must be submitted by April 15.
