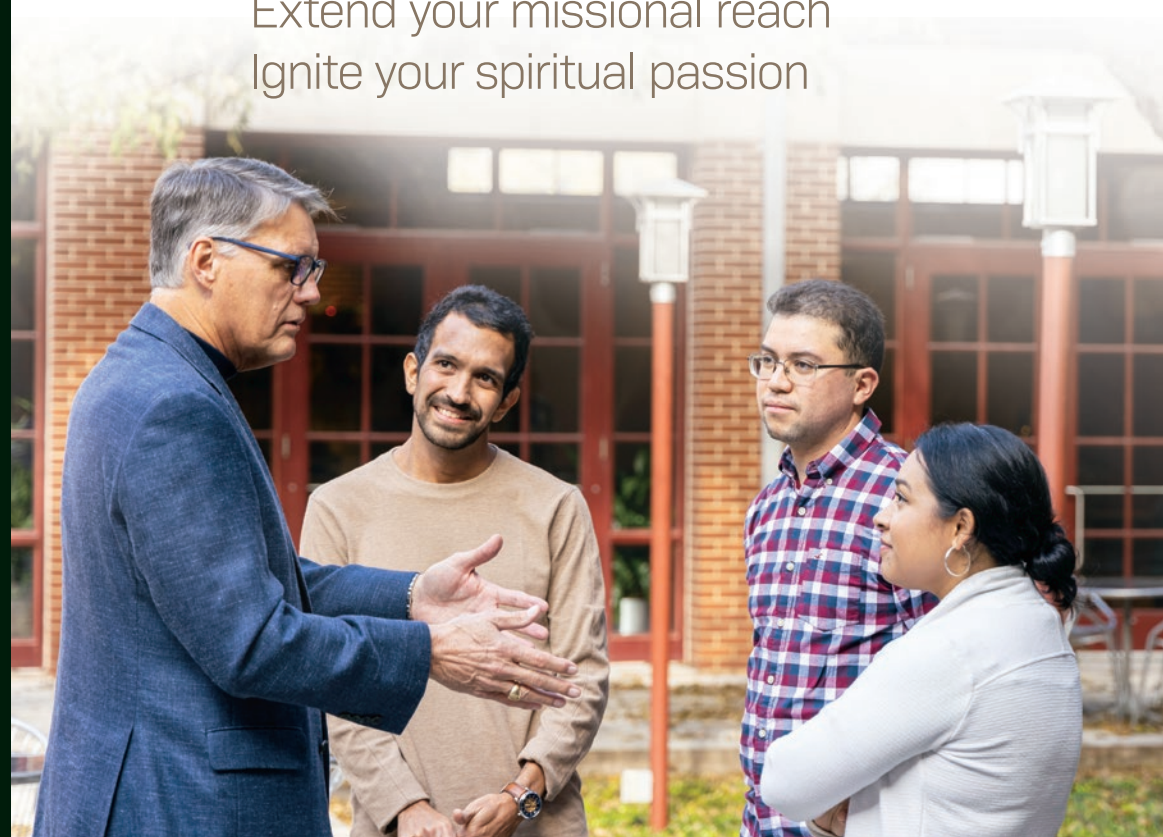

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Truett's three-year Doctor of Ministry degree is built around four intensive Kingdom-oriented seminars along with an Individually Guided Study (IGS) program that culminates in a project-dissertation. The unique quality of our IGS allows students considerable flexibility in crafting research projects that fit their distinctive interests and contexts. Each seminar is led by two instructors – a professor and an experienced practitioner. The IGS is guided by supervisors chosen specifically for the interests of each student.

SPIRITUAL FORMATION: THE SCARLET THREAD

Every student is involved in a spiritual formation group that meets daily during the seminars and monthly via video throughout the program. This creates a fresh pattern for a daily time with God in addition to generating life-long ministry partnerships.

INDIVIDUALLY GUIDED, RELATIONALLY-ENRICHED STUDY

You will work individually with three personal mentors — a professor who serves as your academic advisor and resource person, a ministry practitioner who inspires and guides your practical reflections during the learning process, and a sociologist from Baylor's Institute for the Study of Religion (ISR) who directs the development of your individual project design.
